1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. $18:107(A)$ and (D), $109, 463(A)(1)(a)$ and $551(D)$, relative to the
3	Louisiana Election Code; to provide for consistency of presentation of political party
4	affiliations on voter identification cards, notices of candidacy, voter registration
5	cards and precinct registers; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for
6	related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 18:107(A) and (D), 109, 463(A)(1)(a) and 551(D) are hereby
9	amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§107. Party affiliation not required for registration; change in party affiliation
11	A. An applicant need not be a member of a political party or declare a party
12	affiliation in order to be registered, but in such case the word words "None" "no
13	party'' or an abbreviation thereof on the application form shall be circled.
14	* * *
15	D. If a registrant has registered with a declaration of party affiliation and
16	afterwards desires to affiliate with no party, he shall make written application
17	therefor to the registrar, and the registrar shall enter in the registrant's information
18	on the state voter registration computer system and, if the original application is
19	available in hard copy in the registrar's office, on the original application form, the
20	word words "NONE" "no party" or an abbreviation thereof and the date of the
21	change.

23	\$109. Notice of registration and change in registration
24	After receiving from the registrar the information concerning a new registrant

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1 or the information concerning a change made with respect to the registration of any 2 person, the Department of State promptly shall mail a notice to the appropriate 3 registrar that the person is registered or that his registration has been changed. The 4 registrar shall then mail a notice, postage prepaid, to each new registrant and to each person whose registration was changed in any manner a notice that he is registered 5 or that his registration has been changed. The notice shall show the parish, ward, 6 7 precinct, and registration address, and party affiliation of the registrant. The notice shall list an abbreviation of the name of the political party if the registrant is 8 9 registered as being affiliated with a recognized political party, "other" if the 10 registrant is registered as being affiliated with a political party that is not recognized, or "no party" or an abbreviation thereof if the registrant is 11 12 registered with no political party affiliation. However, the registrar shall not be 13 required to send such a notice to any voter who has been on the inactive list of voters for at least two years unless the change in registration involves a change in the 14 15 voter's address. The secretary of state shall prescribe the form to be used on the notice; however, the front of the notice shall contain directions to the postmaster to 16 17 "deliver only as addressed; otherwise return to sender; address correction requested", 18 and the return address shall be that of the registrar. When a notice is returned by the postmaster, the registrar shall proceed in accordance with the applicable provisions 19 20 of Part V of this Chapter. * 21 22 §463. Notice of candidacy; financial disclosure; political advertising; penalties 23 A.(1)(a) A notice of candidacy shall be in writing and shall state the

candidate's name, the office he seeks, the address of his domicile, <u>and</u> the parish,
ward, and precinct where he is registered to vote, and the political party, if any, with
which he is registered as being affiliated. <u>The candidate shall list on the notice of</u>
<u>candidacy the name of the political party if he is registered as being affiliated</u>
with a recognized political party, "other" if he is registered as being affiliated
with a political party that is not a recognized political party, or "no party" or
an abbreviation thereof if he is registered with no political party affiliation. No

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1	candidate shall change or add his political party designation, for purposes of printing
2	on the election ballot as required by R.S. 18:551(D), after he has qualified for the
3	election.

5	§551. Ballots
6	* * *
7	D. Political party designation. The political party designation of a candidate
8	who is registered as being affiliated with a recognized political party shall be listed
9	on the primary or general election ballot on the same line and immediately after or
10	below the candidate's name. If a candidate is affiliated with a political party, but such
11	party is not a recognized political party, the space word "other" shall be placed
12	after his name shall be left blank. If a candidate is not affiliated with any political
13	party, the words "no party" or an abbreviation thereof shall be placed after his name.
14	The secretary of state shall promulgate and adopt rules as necessary to effectuate the
15	provisions and purposes of this Subsection.
16	* * *
17	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2013; if vetoed by the
18	governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on
19	January 1, 2013, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
