AN ACT

To amend and reenact the introductory paragraph of R.S. 13:841(A) and (2)(c) and (d), relative to miscellaneous fees in civil matters; to provide for setting limits on fees and establishing procedures for the receipt or issuance of certain documents by electronic means; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. The introductory paragraph of R.S. 13:841(A) and (2)(c) and (d) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§841. Enumeration of fees in civil matters; miscellaneous

A. The clerks of the several district courts may be entitled to demand and receive fees of office, which fees may be less than, but shall not exceed, the following amounts: **set forth in this Section. Any clerk of court that establishes procedures for the filing, receipt, or issuance of any of the following documents by electronic means shall establish fees for the filing, receipt, or issuance of electronic documents that shall not exceed the fee that would apply if the document was received, filed, or issued in paper.**

(2) Filing document:

(c) ~~Paper exhibits, attachments, transcripts, and depositions per page, two dollars~~ **Exhibits up to eight and one-half inches by fourteen inches, including but not limited to attachments, transcripts, and depositions, two dollars per page.**

(d) ~~All other exhibits, five dollars~~ **All paper exhibits larger than eight and one-half inches by fourteen inches, five dollars per page and all other exhibits,**
