AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 46:1053(A), relative to hospital service districts; to provide relative to the board of commissioners; to provide relative to qualifications of members; to provide with respect to convicted felons; to provide relative to background checks of persons seeking to serve on the board of commissioners; to provide relative to the duties of the appointing authority of hospital service districts; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 46:1053(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§1053. Commission; qualification of members; appointment; vacancies; compensation; removal of commissioners; certain powers

A.(1) Any hospital service district formed or created under the provisions of this Chapter shall be governed by a board of five commissioners, hereafter referred to as commission, who shall be qualified voters and residents of the district. The commission shall be appointed by the police jury of the parish. Two of the first commissioners so appointed shall serve for two years, two for four years and one for six years.
