1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 47:463.165, relative to motor vehicle special prestige license plates; to provide
3	for the creation, issuance, and design of such license plates; to provide relative to the
4	fee and distribution of such plates; to authorize the promulgation of rules and
5	regulations relative to the creation and implementation of a special prestige license
6	plate; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 47:463.165 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	<u>§463.165. Special prestige license plates; Louisiana Future Farmers of America</u>
10	Foundation, Inc.
11	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections
12	shall establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate for the Louisiana
13	Future Farmers of America Foundation, Inc., provided there is a minimum of
14	one thousand applicants for such plate. These license plates shall be restricted
15	to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, and vans.
16	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the Louisiana Future
17	Farmers of America Foundation, Inc. to select the color and design of the plate
18	provided that it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3).
19	C. The prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
20	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
21	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five
22	dollars for this special prestige license plate that shall be disbursed in
23	accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This fee shall be in addition to the
24	standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article VII, Section 5 of the

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1	Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars and fifty cents for
2	each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative
3	<u>cost.</u>
4	E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and
5	forwarded to the Louisiana Future Farmers of America Foundation, Inc. The
6	monies received from the royalty fees shall be used solely to support the
7	activities of the Louisiana Future Farmers of America Association.
8	F. The secretary shall adopt rules and regulations as are necessary to
9	implement the provisions of this Section.
