DIGEST

Present law defines "convicted" as adjudicated guilty after a plea or after trial on the merits.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the definition of "convicted" to mean adjudicated guilty after a plea or after trial on the merits or adjudicated delinquent of a felony-grade act or a misdemeanor-grade act.
