CIGARS/CIGARETTES. Prohibits alcoholic beverage licensees from accepting nutritional assistance benefits as payment for alcohol and tobacco products. (8/1/12)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 26:90(A)(12) and 286(A)(12), and to enact R.S. 26:911(A)(5),
3	relative to the office of alcohol and tobacco control; to prohibit the acceptance of
4	nutritional assistance benefits for the purchase of alcohol or tobacco products; and
5	to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 26:90(A)(12) and 286(A)(12) are hereby amended and reenacted and
8	R.S. 26:911(A)(5) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§90. Acts prohibited on licensed premises; suspension or revocation of permits
10	A. No person holding a retail dealer's permit and no agent, associate,
11	employee, representative, or servant of any such person shall do or permit any of the
12	following acts to be done on or about the licensed premises:

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the acceptance of food stamp coupons for the payment of alcoholic beverage products.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the references in <u>present law</u> from food stamp coupons to

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program "SNAP" electronic benefit transfer cards.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits certain acts on or about any premises which sells or offers for sale tobacco products.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further prohibits any person, agent, associate, employee, representative, or servant of any person who sells or offers for sale tobacco products from accepting electronic benefit transfer cards as payment for tobacco products in violation of federal provisions.
