2	To amend and reenact R.S. 41:1217.1(B) and R.S. 56:30.3(B) and to enact R.S. 56:799.7,
3	relative to leases of public lands; to provide for certain provisions regarding leases
4	on public lands; to exempt lands administered, controlled or managed by the
5	Department of Wildlife and Fisheries from certain restrictions on public leases; to
6	provide for terms of a lease transferred to the state from another party; to provide
7	terms, conditions, and requirements; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R. S. 41:1217.1(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	\$1217.1. Renewal of lease; highest bid option
11	* * *
12	B. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, if the commissioner
13	or secretary determines there exists a public need to maintain the current lessee most
14	recent lessee of record, his heirs, or assignees, the commissioner or secretary may
15	offer the current lessee most recent lessee of record, his heirs, or assignees, if he
16	made a bid, the option to match the highest bid in order to continue to lease the state
17	lands. The provisions of this Subsection shall apply to lessees who held a lease
18	with another party, which lease was subsequently transferred to the state. The
19	provisions of this Subsection shall not apply to oyster leases, alligator leases, or oil
20	and gas leases entered into by the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, or to any
21	lease entered into by the State Mineral and Energy Board.

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1	Section 2. R.S. 56:30.3(B) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 56:799.7 is
2	hereby enacted to read as follows:
3	§30.3. Lease of state lands; access to public waterways
4	* * *
5	B. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, if the secretary
6	determines there exists a public need to maintain the current lessee, most recent
7	lessee of record, his heirs, or assignees, the secretary may offer the current lessee
8	most recent lessee of record, his heirs, or assignees, if he made a bid, the option
9	to match the highest bid in order to continue to lease the state lands. The
10	provisions of this Subsection shall apply to lessees who held a lease with another
11	party, which lease was subsequently transferred to the state. The provisions of
12	this Subsection shall not apply to oyster leases, oil and gas leases or alligator leases
13	entered into by the department, or to any lease entered into by the State Mineral and
14	Energy Board. The department shall promulgate rules and regulations providing for
15	uniform criteria to assess the management of leased property.

17	§799.7. Exemption from restrictions of area and number; fair market value
18	A. At the end of the term of a lease which was issued on property
19	governed by the provisions of this Subpart which lease was transferred to the
20	state through the act of donation, the property subject to such lease may be
21	offered by the department for lease. Such lease shall be deemed a new lease and
22	shall be offered for public bid under the provisions of Part 1 of Chapter 10 of
23	Title 41 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950. The provisions of R.S.
24	41:1217.1 and R.S. 56:30.3 which allow the secretary to offer the most recent
25	lessee of record, his heirs, or assignees, the option to match the highest bid in
26	order to continue to lease the state land shall apply to any bid process under the
27	provisions of this Subsection. However, such leases, renewals, or extensions
27	provisions of this subsection. However, such reases, renewals, or extensions
27	shall be exempt from the provisions of R.S. 41:1216(A) which limit the total

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1	B. All leases or extensions of leases issued on property governed by the
2	provisions of this Subpart shall be in exchange of consideration proportionate
3	to the fair market lease value of the property to be leased.
4	Section 3. This Act shall become effective on June 23, 2011.
