2	To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1443 and to repeal R.S. 22:1442, relative to surety insurance;
3	to provide for an increase in the minimum premium rate for commercial surety
4	underwriters writing criminal bail bonds; to repeal a requirement that a premium be
5	shown on a power of attorney attached to a bail bond; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 22:1443 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§1443. Premium on criminal bail bond
10	The premium rate set for commercial surety underwriters writing criminal
11	bail bonds in the various courts throughout the state of Louisiana shall not be subject
12	to the rates set by the insurance commissioner, but shall be set and adjusted by the
13	legislature. The rate for all commercial surety underwriters writing criminal bail
14	bonds in the state of Louisiana shall be twelve percent of the face amount of the
15	bond, or sixty one hundred twenty dollars, whichever is greater. Any additional fee
16	authorized by R.S. 13:718(I)(2) shall not be included in this premium rate and shall
17	be exclusive of the limit set by this Section. All other provisions of the code relating
18	to enforcement of the rate shall be effective and enforced in accordance with all parts
19	of this Section.
	Section 2. R.S. 22:1442 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
