2	To enact R.S. 42:1123(44), relative to an exception to the Code of Governmental Ethics; to
3	provide for an exception to certain prohibitions of pharmacists as public servants; to
4	provide an exception to allow a pharmacist to serve on a certain hospital service
5	district; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 42:1123(44) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§1123. Exceptions
9	This Part shall not preclude:
10	* * *
11	(44) A licensed pharmacist who is a member of a board of commissioners
12	for any hospital service district authorized by Chapter 10 of Title 46 of the
13	Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 located within a parish which has a
14	population of one hundred twenty-five thousand or less from contracting with
15	the hospital over which the board exercises jurisdiction, from subcontracting
16	with another provider who contracts with such hospital or pharmacy, or from
17	owning an interest in an entity that contracts with such hospital. However, such
18	licensed pharmacist shall recuse himself from participating in any transaction
19	before the board relating to any contracts entered into by him, or by a provider
20	with which he subcontracts, or by any entity in which he owns an interest.
