TUITION. Constitutional Amendment to authorize the postsecondary education management boards to establish tuition and mandatory fee amounts charged by institutions under their supervision and management. (2/3-CA13sl(A))

A JOINT RESOLUTION

2	Proposing to add Article VIII, Section 7.2 of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative to
3	postsecondary education; to authorize public postsecondary management boards to
4	establish the tuition and mandatory fee amounts charged by the institutions under
5	their supervision and management; and to specify an election for submission of the
6	proposition to electors and provide a ballot proposition.
7	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
8	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state, for
9	their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to add Article VIII,
10	Section 7.2 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
11	§7.2. Postsecondary Education Management Boards; Tuition and Fee Authority
12	Section 7.2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article VII, Section
13	(2.1)(A), or any other provision of this constitution or law to the contrary, any
14	postsecondary education management board created by this Article shall have
15	the authority to establish the tuition and mandatory fee amounts charged by the
16	institutions under its supervision and management.
17	Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted

1 to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 4. 2014. 2 3 Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at said election 4 there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as 5 follows: 6 7 Do you support an amendment to authorize the postsecondary education 8 management boards to establish the tuition and mandatory fee amounts 9 charged by the institutions under their supervision and management, without 10 legislative approval? 11 (Adds Article VIII, Section 7.2)

DIGEST

Nevers (SB 124)

<u>Present constitution</u> (Art. VII, Sec. 2.1(A)) provides that any new fee or civil fine or increase in an existing fee or civil fine imposed or assessed by the state or any board, department, or agency of the state shall require the enactment of a law by a two-thirds vote of the elected members of each house of the legislature.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> provides that, notwithstanding this provision and any other constitutional provision or law to the contrary, the constitutionally created postsecondary education management boards have the authority to establish the tuition and fee amounts charged by the institutions under their supervision and management, without legislative approval.

Specifies submission of the amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on November 4, 2014.
