SENATE BILL NO. 144

BY SENATORS THOMPSON AND WALSWORTH

HOMELAND SECURITY. Provides with respect to the sunset provisions of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness. (6/30/10)

1 AN ACT

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To enact R.S. 49:191(5)(b) and to repeal R.S. 49:191(3)(k), relative to the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, including provisions to provide for the re-creation of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness and the statutory entities made a part of the department by law; to provide for the effective termination date for all statutory authority for the existence of such statutory entities; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. Pursuant to R.S. 49:193, the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness and the statutory entities made a part of the department by law shall be re-created effective June 30, 2010, and all statutory authority therefor is continued in accordance with the provisions of Part XII of Chapter 1 of Title 49 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.

Section 2. All statutory authority for the existence of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness and the statutory entities made a part of the department as re-created by Section 1 of this Act shall cease as of July 1, 2015, pursuant to R.S. 49:191. However, the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency

19	Section 5. R.S. 49:191(3)(k) is hereby repealed in its entirety.
20	Section 6. This Act shall become effective on June 30, 2010; if vetoed by the
21	governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on
22	June 30, 2010, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
