12	developmental disabilities are designated as follows:
13	(1) Greater New Orleans Supports and Services Center.
14	(2) Bayou Region Supports and Services Center.
15	(3)(1) Pinecrest Supports and Services Center.
16	(4) Northeast Supports and Services Center.
17	(5) Columbia Community Residential and Employment Services.
18	(6) (2) Northwest Supports and Services Center.
19	(7) Leesville Residential and Employment Services.
20	(8) Acadiana Region Supports and Services Center.
21	(9)(3) North Lake Supports and Services Center.
22	(10) Acadiana Employment Services at Eunice.
23	(11) Acadiana Employment Services at Opelousas.

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2	B. Pinecrest Supports and Services Center, Northeast Supports and Services
3	Center, Columbia Community Residential and Employment Services, Northwest
4	Supports and Services Center, Leesville Residential and Employment Services,
5	Acadiana Region Supports and Services Center, and North Lake Supports and
6	Services Center, Greater New Orleans Supports and Services Center, Bayou Region
7	Supports and Services Center, Acadiana Employment Services at Eunice, and
8	Acadiana Employment Services at Opelousas are continued as administrative units
9	of this office.

11	Section 2. R.S. 28:894(A)(5) is hereby repealed.
12	Section 3. R.S. 36:259(C)(15), (17) through (20), (22), (25), and (26) are hereby
13	repealed.
14	Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
15	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
16	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
17	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
18	effective on the day following such approval.
