HEALTH SERVICES. Repeals provision providing for payment rates under Title XIX of the Social Security Act medical assistance program for emergency transportation of a person by ambulance. (8/1/12)

1 AN ACT

2 To repeal R.S. 40:1236.3, relative to the medical assistance program for emergency  
3 transportation of a person by ambulance; to repeal the provisions relative to the  
4 payment rates under Title XIX of the Social Security Act medical assistance program  
5 for emergency transportation of a person by ambulance; and to provide for related  
6 matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 40:1236.3 is hereby repealed.

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DIGEST

Present law provides for payment under Title XIX of the Social Security Act medical assistance program for emergency transportation services of a person by ambulance and provides that the rate will be the same rate, but not to exceed the rate established under Medicare and defines emergency medical transportation services.

Proposed law repeals present law as this statute is no longer applicable.

Effective August 1, 2012.
