2	To amend and reenact the title to Part II-B of Chapter 4 of Title 47 of the Louisiana Revised

7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. The title to Part II-B of Chapter 4 of Title 47 of the Louisiana Revised
9	Statutes of 1950, R.S. 47:491(A)(1) and (6), and 492(A), (B), and (E) are hereby amended
10	and reenacted to read as follows:
11	PART II-B. HAM AMATEUR RADIO STATION LICENSE PLATES
12	§491. Legislative findings
13	A.(1) The legislature finds that amateur or "ham" radio station operators have
14	had the privilege of having their own identifiable plates since 1951.

16	(6) The legislature concludes from these findings that the state has a legitimate
17	governmental interest in the issuance of amateur or "ham" radio station license plates
