FUNDS/FUNDING. Requires that any gaming revenues beyond the amounts collected during Fiscal Year 2017-2018 be dedicated to TOPS. (8/1/18)

AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 27:92(B)(2), 270(A)(2)(b) and (3)(a), 392(B)(2)(a) and (C), 437(B)(1)(c) and (2), and 439(A), and to enact R.S. 27:92(D), 270(D), 392(D), 3 4 437(D), and 439(C), relative to gaming revenues which exceed the amounts actually 5 collected during Fiscal Year 2017-2018; to provide that certain river boat gaming proceeds, casino gaming revenues, slot machine proceeds, and video draw poker 6 7 device proceeds and fees shall be used to fund the TOPS program; and to provide for 8 related matters. 9 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 10 Section 1. 25	§439. Video Draw Poker Device Purse Supplement Fund; distribution and
26	expenditure
27	A. Funds specified pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 27:435(D)(4) shall be
28	forwarded by the division to the state treasurer for immediate deposit in the state
29	treasury. The funds so deposited shall first be credited to the Bond Security and

Redemption Fund in accordance with Article VII, Section 9(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana. Thereafter, except as provided in Subsection C of this Section, the state treasurer shall, each fiscal year, credit to a special fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury and entitled the Video Draw Poker Device Purse Supplement Fund, an amount equal to all funds specified pursuant to R.S. 27:435(D)(4). Monies in the Video Draw Poker Purse Supplement Fund shall only be withdrawn pursuant to an appropriation by the legislature and shall be used solely as provided in Subsection B of this Section.

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C. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection A of this Section or any provision of law to the contrary, all revenues in excess of the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 actual collections of the amount equal to all funds specified pursuant to R.S. 27:435(D)(4), shall be dedicated to the TOPS program.

SB 151 Original 2018 Regular Session

<u>Present law</u> provides for the distribution of gaming proceeds from river boat gaming, casino gaming, slot machine gaming, and video draw poker gaming.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but further provides that the gaming revenues which exceed the amounts actually collected during Fiscal Year 2017-2018 from river boat gaming, casino gaming, slot machine gaming, and video draw poker gaming, shall be used to fund the TOPS program.

Effective August 1, 2018.
