9	<u>§73.9. Criminal use of Internet, virtual, street-map; enhanced penalties</u>
10	A. When an Internet, virtual, street-level map is used in the commission
11	<u>of a criminal offense against a person or against property, an additional</u>
12	sentence for a period of not less than one year shall be imposed. The additional
13	penalty imposed pursuant to this Subsection shall be served consecutively with
14	the sentence imposed for the underlying offense.
15	B. When an Internet, virtual, street-level map is used in the commission
16	or attempted commission of an act of terrorism, as is defined in R.S.
17	14:100.12(1), an additional sentence for a period of not less than ten years shall
18	be imposed without the benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of the
19	sentence. The additional penalty imposed pursuant to this Subsection shall be
20	served consecutively with the sentence imposed for the underlying offense.
