HEALTH SERVICES. Provides for requirements of advertising by physicians. (8/15/11)

2	To enact R.S. 37:1285(A)(32), relative to the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners;
3	to provide for advertisement requirements by physicians; to provide for causes for
4	which the board may refuse to issue, or may suspend or revoke, any license or
5	permit, or impose probationary or other restrictions on the license of a physician; and
6	to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 37:1285(A)(32) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§1285. Causes for nonissuance; suspension; revocation; or the imposition of
10	restrictions; fines; reinstatement; publication of action; stays
11	A. The board may refuse to issue, or may suspend or revoke any license or
12	permit, or impose probationary or other restrictions on any license or permit issued
13	under this Part for the following causes:

15	(32) Holding oneself out to the public in any manner as being certified
16	by a public or private board including but not limited to a multidisciplinary
17	board or "board certified", unless all of the following criteria are satisfied:

1	(a) The full name of the board from which the physician is certified and
2	the name of the specialty or subspecialty is included in the advertisement.
3	(b) The board meets any of the following qualifications:
4	(i) The board is an American Board of Medical Specialties member
5	board or an American Osteopathic Association certifying board.
6	(ii) The board has been approved by the Louisiana State Board of
7	Medical Examiners.
8	(iii) A board requiring an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical
9	Education or American Osteopathic Association approved postgraduate
10	training program that provides complete training in that specialty or
11	subspecialty.

Michot (SB 152)

<u>Proposed law</u> adds certain advertisements by a physician holding himself out to the public in any manner as being certified by a public or private board as cause for the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners to refuse to issue or suspend or revoke any license or permit, or impose probationary or other restrictions on the license of the physician, unless certain criteria are satisfied.

Effective August 15, 2011.
