2	To amend and reenact R.S. $13:352(A)(1)$, (2), and (6), relative to certain fees charged by the
3	courts of appeal; to provide for an increase in certain fees for the courts of appeal;
4	to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 13:352(A)(1), (2), and (6) are hereby amended and reenacted to read
7	as follows:
8	§352. Fees; bond premiums; equipment, supplies, and other expenses;
9	reimbursement of expenses of judges of courts of appeal
10	A. The clerks of all of the courts of appeal shall charge the following fees:
11	(1) For filing the record of appeal, one <u>three</u> hundred dollars.
12	(2) For filing an application for writs where the supervisory jurisdiction of
13	the court of appeal is invoked, <u>one hundred</u> fifty dollars.
14	* * *
15	(6) For any other miscellaneous civil matter, up to one hundred dollars.
16	For filing an application for rehearing from any civil appeal or supervisory writ,
17	seventy one hundred dollars.
18	* * *
19	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2015; if vetoed by the governor
20	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
21	2015, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
