AN ACT

To enact R.S. 17:3990(B)(5), relative to the Recovery School District; to provide for binding arbitration to resolve certain disputes between the district and a charter school or a city, parish, or other local public school board; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 17:3990(B)(5) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1990. Recovery School District; creation; governance; operation

* * *

(5) Any dispute between the Recovery School District and a charter school or a city, parish, or other local public school board arising out of a contractual matter shall be referred to and resolved by binding arbitration.

DIGEST

Proposed law provides that any dispute between the Recovery School District and a charter school or a city, parish, or other local public school board arising out of a contractual matter shall be referred to and resolved by binding arbitration.
