#### SENATE BILL NO. 166

## BY SENATORS WALSWORTH AND THOMPSON

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 34:1401(A) and (B) and to enact R.S. 34:1402(C), relative to
3	membership on the Greater Ouachita Port Commission; to provide for residency
4	requirements and removal of commissioners failing to attend the required number
5	of regular meetings; and to provide for related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 34:1401(A) and (B) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 34:
9	1402(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§1401. Creation of commission; membership; qualifications; vacancy
11	A. The Greater Ouachita Port Commission, the "commission", is hereby
12	created. The commission shall be composed of seven members, who shall serve
13	without compensation. The members must be citizens of the United States and
14	qualified electors of the parish of Ouachita and shall be appointed by the governor
15	for overlapping terms of six years, as follows:
16	(1) Two commissioners shall be appointed at large.
17	(2) Two commissioners shall be residents of Ward 3, 4, or 10 District 3
18	consisting of precincts 10 through 24, District 4 consisting of precincts 25 and
19	26, or District 10 consisting of precincts 59 through 72 and 74 through 79 and
20	shall be appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees submitted by the
21	state legislators representing these wards districts.
22	(3) Two commissioners shall be residents of Ward 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9 District 5
23	consisting of precincts 27 through 50, District 6 consisting of precincts 51

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1	through 53, District 7 consisting of precincts 54 and 55, District 8 consisting of
2	precincts 56 and 57, or District 9 consisting of precinct 58 and shall be appointed
3	by the governor from a list of three nominees submitted by the state legislators
4	representing these wards districts.
5	(4) One commissioner shall be a resident of Ward 1 or 2 District 1 consisting
6	of precincts 1 through 5 and precinct 73, or District 2 consisting of precincts 2
7	through 9A and shall be appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees
8	submitted by the state legislators representing these wards districts.
9	B. The commissioner initially appointed from Ward 1 or 2 District 1
10	consisting of precincts 1 through 5 and precinct 73, or District 2 consisting of
11	precincts 2 through 9A and one of the commissioners initially appointed from Ward
12	5, 6, 7, 8, or 9 District 5 consisting of precincts 27 through 50, District 6
13	consisting of precincts 51 through 53, District 7 consisting of precincts 54 and
14	55, District 8 consisting of precincts 56 and 57, or District 9 consisting of
15	precinct 58 shall serve terms of two years; one of the commissioners initially
16	appointed at large and one of the commissioners initially appointed from Ward 3, 4,
17	or 10 District 3 consisting of precincts 10 through 24, District 4 consisting of
18	precincts 25 and 26, or District 10 consisting of precincts 59 through 72 and 74
19	through 79 shall serve terms of four years; and the other three commissioners
20	initially appointed shall serve terms of six years, all as designated by the governor.
21	The successors shall serve terms of six years. Each commissioner shall take and
22	cause to be recorded the oath of office, as required by Article X, Section 30 of the
23	Constitution of Louisiana and R.S. 42:161 et seq.

25	§1402. Officers; meetings; quorum; removal
26	* * *
27	C. Members who fail to attend three or more consecutive regular
28	meetings may be removed by a majority of commission members present at a
29	regular or special meeting of the commission. Filling vacancies created by
30	removal shall be pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 34:1401(A) and (B).

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1	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bill to become law without signature
3	by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana; if
4	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
5	effective on the day following such approval by, whichever is later.
