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SCHOOLS. Provides relative to the jurisdiction of the Central Community School System. (7/1/22)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:66(A)(2), relative to the jurisdiction of the Central
3	Community School System; to provide with respect to the boundaries of the school
4	system; to provide for current students who reside in the area; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 17:66(A)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§66. Central Community School Board and school system; creation; membership;
10	qualifications; apportionment; election; powers, duties, and
11	functions; system operation
12	A. * * *
13	(2) The (a) Prior to July 1, 2022, the geographic boundaries of the school
14	system shall be as follows:
15	Commence at a point on the Comite River at the center line of the river and
16	its intersection with the center line of Louisiana Highway 64; thence proceed in a
17	southerly direction along the center line of the Comite River to its intersection with

1 the center line of White Bayou; thence proceed in a northwesterly direction along the 2 center line of White Bayou to a point due east of the intersection of Foster Road and Green Gate Drive; thence run due west from said point 3500 feet, more or less, along 3 a line to its intersection with the center line of Foster Road; thence proceed in a 4 5 southerly direction along the center line of Foster Road to its intersection with the center line of Louisiana Highway 408 (Hooper Road); thence proceed in an easterly 6 7 direction along the center line of Louisiana Highway 408 (Hooper Road) ninety feet, 8 more or less, to its intersection with an electric power transmission line on the 9 western boundary of the Four Seasons Trailer Park; thence proceed in a southerly 10 direction along the electric power transmission line and its extension to its 11 intersection with the center line of Cypress Bayou; thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along the center line of Cypress Bayou to its intersection with the center 12 13 line of the Comite River; thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along the center line of the Comite River to its confluence with the center line of the Amite River; 14 thence proceed in a northerly direction along the center line of the meanders of the 15 16 Amite River to its confluence with the center line of Sandy Creek; thence proceed in a northerly direction along the center line of Sandy Creek to its intersection with 17 the center line of Louisiana Highway 37 (Greenwell Springs Road); thence proceed 18 19 in a southwesterly direction along the center line of Louisiana Highway 37 (Greenwell Springs Road) to its intersection with the center line of Louisiana 20 Highway 409 (Liberty Road); thence proceed in a northerly direction along the 21 center line of Louisiana Highway 409 (Liberty Road) to its intersection with the 22 center line of Louisiana Highway 64 (Greenwell Springs-Port Hudson Road); thence 23 continue north along the center line of Louisiana Highway 409 (Liberty Road) a 24 distance of 1000 feet to a point; thence proceed from said point northwesterly along 25 a line 1000 feet north of and parallel to Louisiana Highway 64 (Greenwell Springs-26 27 Port Hudson Road) to its intersection with the east boundary of Section 16, Township 5 South, Range 2 East; thence proceed along the east boundary of Section 28 29 16, north a distance of 2200 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of Section 16; 1

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thence, along the north boundary of Section 16, proceed west a distance of 3100 feet, more or less, to the northwest corner of Section 16; thence, along the west boundary of Section 16, proceed south a distance of 1000 feet, more or less, to a point on the west boundary of Section 16 that is 1000 feet north of the center line of Louisiana Highway 64; thence proceed in a northwesterly direction along a line 1000 feet north of and parallel to Louisiana Highway 64 to a point 500 feet west of Saunders Bayou; thence proceed southerly along a line 500 feet west of Saunders Bayou to its intersection with the center line of Louisiana Highway 64; thence proceed in a westerly direction along the center line of Louisiana Highway 64 to its intersection with the center line of the Comite River, the point of beginning.

(b)(i) Beginning July 1, 2022, the geographic boundaries of the school system shall be as follows:

Commence at a point on the Comite River at the center line of the river and its intersection with the center line of Louisiana Highway 64; thence proceed in a southerly direction along the center line of the Comite River to its confluence with the center line of the Amite River; thence proceed in a northerly direction along the center line of the meanders of the Amite River to its confluence with the center line of Sandy Creek; thence proceed in a northerly direction along the center line of Sandy Creek to its intersection with the center line of Louisiana Highway 37 (Greenwell Springs Road); thence proceed in a southwesterly direction along the center line of Louisiana Highway 37 (Greenwell Springs Road) to its intersection with the center line of Louisiana Highway 409 (Liberty Road); thence proceed in a northerly direction along the center line of Louisiana Highway 409 (Liberty Road) to its intersection with the center line of Louisiana Highway 64 (Greenwell Springs-Port Hudson Road); thence continue north along the center line of Louisiana Highway 409 (Liberty Road) a distance of 1000 feet to a point; thence proceed from said point northwesterly along a line 1000 feet north of and parallel to Louisiana Highway 64 (Greenwell Springs-Port Hudson Road) to its intersection with the east

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1	boundary of Section 16, Township 5 South, Range 2 East; thence proceed along
2	the east boundary of Section 16, north a distance of 2200 feet, more or less, to
3	the northeast corner of Section 16; thence, along the north boundary of Section
4	16, proceed west a distance of 3100 feet, more or less, to the northwest corner
5	of Section 16; thence, along the west boundary of Section 16, proceed south a
6	distance of 1000 feet, more or less, to a point on the west boundary of Section
7	16 that is 1000 feet north of the center line of Louisiana Highway 64; thence
8	proceed in a northwesterly direction along a line 1000 feet north of and parallel
9	to Louisiana Highway 64 to a point 500 feet west of Saunders Bayou; thence
10	proceed southerly along a line 500 feet west of Saunders Bayou to its
11	intersection with the center line of Louisiana Highway 64; thence proceed in a
12	westerly direction along the center line of Louisiana Highway 64 to its
13	intersection with the center line of the Comite River, the point of beginning.
14	(ii) Any student residing within the boundaries of the Central
15	Community School System as prescribed in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph
16	and who was enrolled in the Central Community School System in the 2021-
17	2022 school year may elect to remain enrolled in the Central Community School
18	System until such time as the student graduates from high school or fails to
19	remain continuously enrolled in the Central Community School System. The
20	student shall be included in the membership count for the school system in
21	which he enrolls for all purposes, including state funding through the Minimum
22	Foundation Program formula.

24	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2022; if vetoed by the governor
25	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day

following such approval by the legislature or July 1, 2022, whichever is later.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the Central Community School System (CCSS) and the geographic boundaries of the school system.

Proposed law beginning July 1, 2022, adjusts CCSS's geographic boundaries.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any student residing within the original geographic boundaries of CCSS and who was enrolled in CCSS during the 2021-2022 school year may elect to remain enrolled in CCSS until such time as the student graduates from high school or fails to remain continuously enrolled in CCSS.

<u>Proposed law</u> clarifies that such student in the effected area shall be included in the membership count for the school system in which he enrolls for all purposes, including state funding through the Minimum Foundation Program (MFP) formula.

Effective July 1, 2022.
