MEDICAID. Provides for Medicaid reimbursement rate increases. (8/1/24)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 46:460.76.1, relative to Medicaid reimbursement rate increases; to provide for
3	a plan for physicians to be reimbursed at one hundred percent of Medicare rates; to
4	provide for approval and appropriation prior to implementation; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 46:460.76.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§460.76.1. Medicaid physician reimbursement plan; Medicare rate
9	<u>comparability</u>
10	A.(1) The Louisiana Department of Health shall develop a plan for
11	increased Medicaid managed care organization reimbursement rates and fee-
12	for-service reimbursement rates to physicians at one hundred percent of
13	Medicare rates. The plan shall be implemented starting with Fiscal Year 2025-
14	2026 and shall include incremental rate increases, no less than annually, to
15	achieve full Medicare rate comparability no later than Fiscal Year 2027-2028.
16	(2) In developing the plan required by this Section, the department shall
17	prioritize physician provided primary care, obstetric care, non-specialty mental

1	health, substance use disorder, family planning, and women's health services.
2	(3) The plan shall include Medicaid reimbursement rates for service
3	rates of one hundred percent of the Medicare rate for procedure codes utilized
4	for evaluation and management for primary care and specialty office visits,
5	preventative services, care management, obstetric services, and non-specialty
6	mental health services beginning in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 and increasing
7	incrementally through Fiscal Year 2027-2028.
8	(4) The department shall calculate an equivalent rate increase for
9	physician services that do not have a rate established by Medicare.
10	B. The plan shall include procedure codes identified as physician
11	primary care or general care to be reimbursed to physicians at the rate
12	established pursuant to this Section.
13	C. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to prevent the department
14	from doing any of the following:
15	(1) Achieving Medicare rate comparability earlier than Fiscal Year
16	2027-2028 if funding is available.
17	(2) Including other Medicaid provider types in the department's
18	Medicare rate comparability plan after physicians obtain Medicare rate
19	comparability if funding is available.
20	(3) Continuing to provide physicians with supplemental payments in
21	accordance with the department's physician upper payment limit, full Medicaid
22	pricing payment program as approved by the Centers for Medicare and
23	Medicaid Services.
24	D. The department shall complete the plan required by this Section in
25	time to begin providing increased payments to physicians in Fiscal Year 2025-
26	2026. Implementation of the plan shall be subject to any necessary approval by
27	the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and appropriation by the
28	legislature.
