3	renewal elections of parcel fees for the Lakewood East Security and Neighborhood

6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 33:9080.3(F)(3)(c) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8	follows:
9	§9080.3. The Lakewood East Security and Neighborhood Improvement District

11	F. Parcel fee. The governing authority of the city of New Orleans is hereby
12	authorized to impose and collect a parcel fee within the district subject to and in
13	accordance with the provisions of this Subsection:
14	* * *
15	(3) * * * *
16	* * *
17	(c) If approved, the fee shall expire on December 31, 2018, but the fee may
18	be renewed if approved by a majority of the registered voters of the district voting
19	on the proposition at an election as provided in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph.
20	Any election to authorize the renewal of the fee shall be held only at the same time
21	as the mayoral primary election for the city of New Orleans for that purpose in
22	accordance with the Louisiana Election Code. If the fee is renewed, the term of
23	the imposition of the fee shall be as provided in the proposition authorizing such
24	renewal, not to exceed eight years.
