DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides that an open alcoholic beverage container does not mean any bottle, can, or other receptacle that contains a frozen alcoholic beverage unless the lid is removed, a straw protrudes therefrom, or the contents of the receptacle have been partially removed.

<u>Proposed law</u> further describes <u>present law</u> in defining an open alcoholic beverage in a motor vehicle to include a bottle, can, or other receptacle that contains a frozen alcoholic beverage with a lid design that permits access by a straw.

Effective August 15, 2010.
