TAX/TAXATION. Authorizes the voters in the parish of Orleans to decide how hospitality taxes are dedicated. (8/1/19)

SB 204 Original

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the governing authority for the parish of Orleans to hold an election to determine how dedicated hospitality taxes are distributed.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that the election is approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting on the proposition at an election held for that purpose and conducted in accordance with the Louisiana Election Code.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the following definitions:

- (1) "Authority" means the Ernest N. Morial New Orleans Exhibition Hall Authority.
- (2) "Dedicated hospitality taxes" mean hotel occupancy taxes and food and beverage taxes collected by the Authority.

Effective August 1, 2019.
