3	To amend and reenact R.S. 18:1400.2(A), the introductory paragraph of (B)(1), and (C)(1)
4	and 1400.8, relative to election costs; to provide for the payment of certain election
5	expenses incurred by a registrar of voters; to provide for an effective date; and to
6	provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 18:1400.2(A), the introductory paragraph of (B)(1), and (C)(1) and
9	1400.8 are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§1400.2. Election costs paid by secretary of state; governing authorities;
11	reimbursement
12	A. The costs of publication of the location of polling places; of renting
13	polling places; of drayage; of setting up voting machines; of compensating
14	commissioners and deputy parish custodians; of paying election expenses incurred
15	by a registrar of voters and his permanent employees as provided by R.S.
16	<u>18:1400.8</u> ; and of transmitting election returns for gubernatorial and congressional
17	elections, whether or not a gubernatorial or congressional candidate appears on the
18	ballot, shall be paid by the state from funds appropriated to the secretary of state for
19	that purpose, except that when a local or municipal candidate or a local bond, debt,
20	tax, proposition, or question also appears on the ballot, the state shall be required to
21	pay one-half of such costs. The remaining one-half shall be prorated between the
22	state and all local or municipal entities participating in such election. In the case of
23	the offices of justice of the peace and constable of a justice of the peace court, the
24	costs shall be prorated to the parish governing authority. The pro rata share of a local
25	or municipal entity shall be determined by dividing the number of that entity's
26	offices, propositions, or questions on the ballot by the total number of all offices,
27	propositions, or questions on the ballot within that local jurisdiction.

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1	B.(1) The cost of publication of the location of polling places; of renting
2	polling places; of drayage; of setting up voting machines; of compensating

5	<u>18:1400.8</u> ; and of transmitting election returns for any special election when any of
6	the following appear on the ballot shall be paid by the state from funds appropriated
7	to the secretary of state for that purpose:

9	C.(1) The cost of publication of the location of polling places; of renting
10	polling places; of drayage; of setting up voting machines, which cost shall be ten
11	dollars per machine; of compensating commissioners and deputy parish custodians;
12	of paying election expenses incurred by a registrar of voters and his permanent
13	employees as provided by R.S. 18:1400.8; and of transmitting election returns for
14	any election not provided for in Subsections A and B of this Section shall be paid by
15	the appropriate governing authority that relates to the character of office or issue
16	involved in such election. In the case of the offices of justice of the peace and
17	constable of a justice of the peace court, the costs shall be prorated to the parish
18	governing authority. Except as provided in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, if more
19	than one governing authority is involved in an election, a statement of such expenses
20	shall be transmitted to each governing authority involved in the election and payment
21	thereof shall be prorated among the governing authorities as equitably as possible.

23	§1400.8. Expenses incurred by registrars of voters conducting early voting; payment
24	by secretary of state
25	Election expenses incurred by a registrar of voters and his permanent
26	employees to perform election duties and responsibilities associated with early
27	voting on any day during the week between 4:30 p.m. and the time that early voting
28	terminates that day and on any Saturday on which early voting is conducted shall be
29	paid by the state from funds appropriated to the secretary of state for that purpose
30	and shall be a reimbursable election expense as provided by R.S. 18:1400.2.

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1	Section 2. R.S. 18:1400.2(A), the introductory paragraph of (B)(1), and (C)(1) and
2	1400.8 are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
3	§1400.2. Election costs paid by secretary of state; governing authorities;
4	reimbursement
5	A. The costs of publication of the location of polling places; of renting
6	polling places; of drayage; of setting up voting machines; of compensating
7	commissioners and deputy parish custodians; of paying election expenses incurred
8	by a registrar of voters and his permanent employees as provided by R.S. 18:1400.8;
9	and of transmitting election returns for gubernatorial and congressional elections,
10	whether or not a gubernatorial or congressional candidate appears on the ballot, shall
11	be paid by the state from funds appropriated to the secretary of state for that purpose,
12	except that when a local or municipal candidate or a local bond, debt, tax,
13	proposition, or question also appears on the ballot, the state shall be required to pay
14	one-half of such costs. The remaining one-half shall be prorated between the state
15	and all local or municipal entities participating in such election. In the case of the
16	offices of justice of the peace and constable of a justice of the peace court, the costs
17	shall be prorated to the parish governing authority. The pro rata share of a local or
18	municipal entity shall be determined by dividing the number of that entity's offices,
19	propositions, or questions on the ballot by the total number of all offices,

4	any election not provided for in Subsections A and B of this Section shall be paid by

6	involved in such election. In the case of the offices of justice of the peace and
7	constable of a justice of the peace court, the costs shall be prorated to the parish
8	governing authority. Except as provided in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, if more

14	payment by secretary of state
15	Election expenses incurred by a registrar of voters and his permanent
16	employees to perform election duties and responsibilities associated with early
17	voting on any day during the week between 4:30 p.m. and the time that early voting
18	terminates that day and on any Saturday on which early voting is conducted shall be
19	paid by the state from funds appropriated to the secretary of state for that purpose
20	and shall be a reimbursable election expense as provided by R.S. 18:1400.2.
21	Section 3.(A) This Section and Section 1 of this Act shall become effective
22	on January 1, 2016.
