CRIMINAL RECORDS. Allow private companies to monitor the criminal justice information system by providing real time electronic access to the system. (8/15/11)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 15:578 (G), relative to criminal identification and information; to provide for  
3 private agencies to monitor the criminal justice information system; to provide for  
4 certain procedures; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 15:578 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §578. Functions, powers, and duties of the bureau; crime laboratory

8 \* \* \*

9 **G. The bureau shall provide real time electronic access to the criminal**  
10 **justice information system to private companies upon written request from the**  
11 **private entity, in order to monitor the system for criminal information or**  
12 **criminal activity.**

DIGEST

Proposed law requires the bureau to provide real time electronic access to the criminal

justice information system for private companies, upon written request, to monitor the system for criminal information or criminal activity.
