LIBRARIES. Provides relative to the disposition of unused books in the Livingston Parish Library. (8/1/18)

2 To enact R.S. 25:151(B)(5) and (C)(4), relative to the Livingston Parish Library; to provide relative to the disposition of surplus library books; to authorize the library, subject 3 to the approval of its governing board, to sell such books; to provide relative to the 4 5 disposition of proceeds collected from such sales; to provide relative to the location 6 of such sales; and to provide for related matters. 7 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published. 8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 9 Section 1. R.S. 25:151(B)(5) and (C)(4) are hereby enacted to read as follows: 10 §151. Public libraries; disposition of unused books; purpose; definitions 11 B. 12 13 (5)(a) The Livingston Parish Library, subject to the approval of the Livingston Parish Library Board of Control, may sell any superseded, obsolete, 14 15 or otherwise unnecessary book in the possession of the library to any hospital, 16 correctional facility, public or private institution, nonprofit organization, adult education program, youth organization, school, or individual. 17

1 (b) The proceeds collected from the sale of library books pursuant to 2 Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be remitted to the Livingston Parish 3 Library Board of Control and shall be used exclusively for the maintenance, 4 operation, and support of the Livingston Parish Library. 5 C. 6 7 (4) The Livingston Parish Library may dispose of books as provided in 8 Paragraph (B)(5) of this Section by making such books available for purchase 9 at a convenient location to be determined by the Livingston Parish Library 10 **Board of Control.** 11

SB 214 Original

<u>Present law</u> provides that each public library in the state may dispose of any superseded, obsolete, unused, or otherwise unnecessary book by permitting it to be claimed by any hospital, correctional facility, public or private institution, nonprofit organization, adult education program, youth organization, school, or any individual for private use free of charge. <u>Present law</u> requires a public library seeking to dispose of books as provided in <u>present law</u> to do so by making all such books available to be selected for ownership in a convenient location in the library.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides exceptions for the Webster Parish Library and the Calcasieu Parish Library by authorizing the libraries, subject to the approval of the their respective parish library boards of control, to sell such books to the above-mentioned entities. <u>Present law</u> requires that the proceeds collected from the sales be remitted to each parish's library board of control and requires that the proceeds be used exclusively for the maintenance, operation, and support of the respective library.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally authorizes the Livingston Parish Library, subject to the approval of the Livingston Parish Library Board of Control, to sell such books to the above-mentioned entities. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the proceeds collected from such sales shall be remitted to the Livingston Parish Library Board of Control and requires that the proceeds be used exclusively for the maintenance, operation, and support of the Livingston Parish Library.
