1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 9:4815, relative to the Private Works Act; to provide for the escrow of funds
3	due under certain contracts; to provide for the duties of an escrow agent; to provide
4	for the release of funds from escrow; to provide for exceptions; to provide for a
5	limitation of liability; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 9:4815 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§4815. Escrow of funds due under contract; procedures
9	A. When, under the provisions of this Part, a contract in the amount of
10	fifty thousand dollars or more is entered into between an owner and a
11	contractor and if in accordance with the terms of such contract funds earned by
12	the contractor are withheld as retainage by the owner from periodic payments
13	due to the contractor then such funds shall be deposited by the owner into an
14	interest bearing escrow account. The provisions of this Section shall not apply
15	to a contract for a single family residence or double family residence. The
16	provisions of this Section also shall not apply to a contract for the construction
17	or improvement of the following types of industrial facilities that are, or will be
18	engaged in activities defined or classified under one or more of the following
19	subsectors, industry groups, or industries of the 1997 North American Industry
20	Classifications System (NAICS):
21	(1) 22111 electric power generation.
22	(2) 321 wood products manufacturing.
23	(3) 322 paper manufacturing.
24	(4) 324 petroleum and coal products manufacturing.
25	(5) 325 chemical manufacturing.
26	(6) 326 plastics and rubber products manufacturing.
27	(7) 331 primary metals manufacturing.

8	B. An escrow account under the provisions of this Section shall be
9	located at a qualified financial institution and shall be under the control of an
10	escrow agent. The escrow account and escrow agent shall be selected by mutual
11	agreement between the owner and the contractor.
12	C. Upon completion of the work that is the subject of the contract, the
13	funds, including any interest located in the escrow account shall be released
14	from escrow under the following conditions:
15	(1) If there are no existing claims by the owner, the whole amount shall
16	be paid to the contractor within three business days upon receipt by the escrow
17	agent of a written release signed by the contractor and the owner.
18	(2) If there is a dispute between the owner and contractor and the
19	contract does not provide for binding arbitration of such dispute:
20	(a) Undisputed amounts shall be released by the escrow agent within
21	three business days of receipt of a notarized request of the contractor.
22	(b) Disputed amounts that are the subject of a judicial proceeding shall
23	be released by the escrow agent within three business days of the receipt of a
24	final order by the court. Upon receipt of the order of the court, the escrow
25	agent shall pay the contractor or owner such amounts as are determined by the
26	court.
27	(3) If there is a dispute between the owner and contractor and the
28	contract provides for binding arbitration of such dispute, the following shall
29	occur:
30	(a) Undisputed amounts shall be released by the escrow agent within

three business days of receipt of a notarized request of the contractor.

2 (b) Disputed amounts that are the subject of binding arbitration under 3 the contract shall be released by the escrow agent within three business days of the receipt of a final order by the arbitrator who has been selected by mutual 4 agreement between the owner and the contractor. Upon receipt of the order of 5 the arbitrator, the escrow agent shall pay the contractor or owner such amounts 6 7 as are determined by the arbitrator under the rules as defined in the contract 8 between the owner and the contractor. 9 D. Receipt by the escrow agent or the qualified financial institution in 10 which the escrow account is maintained of what purports to be a written release 11 signed by the contractor and owner, or an order by a court or arbitrator, shall 12 be a full release and discharge of the escrow agent for transfer of funds to the 13 contractor. Neither the escrow agent nor the qualified financial institution in which the escrow account is maintained shall be held liable to any party based 14 15 on any claim that the written release is unauthorized, forged, or otherwise fraudulent. 16 E. Neither the escrow agent nor the qualified financial institution in 17 18 which the escrow account is maintained pursuant to the provisions of this 19 Section shall have any liability to the owner, contractor, or any other person 20 when complying with the provisions of this Section.
