2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:262(A), relative to public schools; to require instruction on
3	the patriotic customs of the United States, including the national motto; to require
4	each public school governing authority to display the national motto in each building
5	it uses and in each school under its jurisdiction; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:262(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§262. Flag and patriotic customs of the United States; required instruction
9	A.(1) Not later than the 2000-2001 school year, a A program of instruction
10	on the flag of the United States of America shall be provided to students by the fifth
11	grade as part of the social studies curriculum in the public elementary schools of this
12	state. Such instruction, at a minimum, shall include the history of the American flag,
13	etiquette, customs pertaining to the display and use of the flag, and such other
14	patriotic exercises customs as provided by and in accordance with the provisions of
15	36 U.S.C. 170 et seq. on patriotic customs.
16	(2) Not later than the 2019-2020 school year, the program of instruction
17	on patriotic customs required by this Section shall include instruction on the
18	national motto, "In God We Trust", and each public school governing authority
19	shall display the national motto in each building it uses and in each school under
20	its jurisdiction. The nature of the display shall be determined by each governing
21	authority with a minimum requirement of a paper sign.

23	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
24	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
