AN ACT

To repeal Chapter 5-R of Title 25 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 25:380.151 through 380.156, and to repeal R.S. 36:744(BB) and 801.22, relative to the Germantown Colony Museum; to remove the museum from the jurisdiction of the Department of State and to delete all statutory provisions relative to the museum and its governing board; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. Chapter 5-R of Title 25 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 25:380.151 through 380.156, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. R.S. 36:744 (BB) and 801.22 are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Act shall become effective on February 1, 2017; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on February 1, 2017, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

Present law establishes the Germantown Colony Museum in the city of Minden, in Webster Parish, under the overall jurisdiction of the Department of State and further provides for an advisory board for the museum.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective February 1, 2017.
