LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS. Designates the tea cake as the official state cookie. (gov sig)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 49:170.17, relative to state symbols; to designate the tea cake as the official
3	state cookie; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 49:170.17 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	<u>§170.17. State cookie</u>
7	There shall be an official state cookie. The official state cookie shall be
8	the tea cake. Its use on official documents of the state along with the insignia
9	of the state is hereby authorized.
10	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
11	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
12	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
13	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
14	effective on the day following such approval.

DIGEST

Proposed law designates the tea cake as the official state cookie.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
