Whoever commits an aggravated assault with a firearm shall be fined not 14 more than five ten thousand dollars or imprisoned for not more than five ten years, 15 with or without hard labor, or both. 16 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 17 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 18 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 19 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 20 effective on the day following such approval.
