SENATE BILL NO. 257

VIDEO POKER. Provides that the Louisiana Gaming Control Board may waive the fuel sales requirement under certain conditions at a video poker truck stop facility. (8/1/20)

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 27:416(C)(3)(c), relative to the Video Poker Devices Control Law; to provide for licenses and types of licensing; to provide for qualified truck stop facilities, number of devices, and fuel sales; to provide for force majeure or catastrophic events; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 27:416(C)(3)(c) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§416. Qualified truck stop facilities; number of devices; fuel sales

* * *

C. * * *

(3) * * *

(c) If, for reasons of force majeure or other catastrophic event, fifty percent or more of a qualified truck stop facility is destroyed and must be rebuilt according to certain local, state, or federal building code standards which would inhibit the facility's ability to meet the fuel requirements of this Subsection, such qualified truck stop facility that has been in operation for ten or more years and has maintained fuel sales in compliance with this Subsection,
