<u>Proposed law</u> provides for BESE to adopt rules and regulations (in accordance with the APA and any applicable federal standards) to require that on and after August 1, 2025, every school bus used primarily for the transportation of students be equipped with passenger compartment heating and air conditioning systems.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that notwithstanding certain provisions of <u>present law</u> relative to the construction, design, equipment, and operation of school buses, BESE must require each governing authority of each public elementary and secondary school and each nonpublic elementary and secondary school approved by the board to comply with such rules and regulations.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
