2	To amend and reenact R.S. 25:376, 379.4 and 1245, and to enact R.S. 25:380.3(C),
3	380.34(C), 380.44(C), 380.54(C), 380.64(C), 380.74(C), 380.84(C), 380.94(C),
4	380.104(C), 380.114(C), 380.124(C), 380.134(C), 380.154(C) and 380.165(C),
5	relative to operations of the Old State Capitol and certain museums; to authorize the
6	Department of State to temporarily close the Old State Capitol and certain museums
7	under its jurisdiction when sufficient funds are not appropriated for the operation of
8	such facilities; and to provide for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 25:376, 379.4 and 1245 are hereby amended and reenacted, and R.S.
11	25:380.3(C), 380.34(C), 380.44(C), 380.54(C), 380.64(C), 380.74(C), 380.84(C), 380.94(C),
12	380.104(C), 380.114(C), 380.124(C), 380.134(C), 380.154(C) and 380.165(C) are hereby
13	enacted to read as follows:
14	§376. Operating funds
15	$\underline{\mathbf{A}}$ . The legislature shall provide sufficient funds for the proper operation of
16	the Old State Capitol.
17	B.(1) If sufficient funds necessary for the operation of the Old State
18	Capitol are not appropriated by the legislature, and funds from other local,
19	public, or private sources are not available for this purpose, the Department of
20	State is authorized to temporarily close the Old State Capitol to the public until
21	such time as sufficient funds necessary for the operation of the Old State
22	Capitol are appropriated by the legislature. The Department of State shall
23	maintain the Old State Capitol during any period of temporary closure.
24	(2) The Department of State may accept and use, in accordance with law,
25	gifts, grants, bequests, donations, endowments, or funds from any public or
26	private source to support the operations of the Old State Capitol.

2	$\underline{\mathbf{A}}_{\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ The Department of State shall include in its annual budget request
3	submission, as required by R.S. 39:32, a request for funds necessary for support of
4	the Louisiana State Exhibit Museum. The governor shall include in the executive
5	budget submitted to the legislature sufficient funding for the support of operations
6	of the museum.
7	B.(1) If sufficient funds necessary for the operation of the Louisiana
8	State Exhibit Museum are not appropriated by the legislature, and funds from
9	other local, public, or private sources are not available for this purpose, the
10	Department of State is authorized to temporarily close the museum to the public

24	operation of the Eddie G. Robinson Museum shall be used solely for that purpose
25	and in accordance with the budget plan developed by the commission.
26	B.(1) If sufficient funds necessary for the operation of the Eddie G.
27	Robinson Museum are not appropriated by the legislature, and funds from
28	other local, public, or private sources are not available for this purpose, the
29	Department of State is authorized to temporarily close the museum to the public
30	until such time as sufficient funds necessary for the operation of the museum

1 are appropriated by the legislature. The Department of State shall maintain the 2 museum during any period of temporary closure. 3 (2) The Department of State may accept and use, in accordance with law, 4 gifts, grants, bequests, donations, endowments, or funds from any public or 5 private source to support the operations of the museum. Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 6 7 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 8 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 9 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 10 effective on the day following such approval.
