2	To amend and reenact Code of Criminal Procedure Article 977(C)(2) and to enact Code of
3	Criminal Procedure Article 978(B)(4), relative to the expungement of domestic
4	abuse battery convictions; to prohibit the expungement of convictions of domestic
5	abuse battery; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. Code of Criminal Procedure Article 977(C)(2) is hereby amended and
8	reenacted and Code of Criminal Procedure Article 978(B)(4) is hereby enacted to read as
9	follows:
10	Art. 977. Motion to expunge a record of arrest and conviction of a misdemeanor
11	offense

13	C. No person shall be entitled to expungement of a record under either of the
14	following circumstances:

16	(2) The misdemeanor conviction was for domestic abuse battery which was
17	not dismissed pursuant to Article 894(B) of this Code.

19	Art. 978. Motion to expunge record of arrest and conviction of a felony offense

21	B. No expungement shall be granted nor shall a person be permitted to file
22	a motion to expunge the record of arrest and conviction of a felony offense if the
23	person was convicted of the commission or attempted commission of any of the
24	following offenses:

1 2 (4) The conviction was for domestic abuse battery. 3 4 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 5 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 6 7 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 8 effective on the day following such approval.
