<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 17:3074.1(C)) provides that by January 1, 2022, and at least once every three years thereafter, the advisory council must review the workforce priorities of the state and each of its workforce regions and designate qualified programs.

<u>Proposed law</u> deletes <u>present law</u> and provides that the Louisiana Workforce Commission convene the advisory council annually for program updates. Further provides that at least once every three years, the advisory council must review the workforce priorities of the state and each of its workforce regions and designate qualified programs.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 17:3074.4(C)) provides that state appropriations for the program cannot exceed \$10,500,000 per year for students enrolled in public postsecondary education institutions or proprietary schools.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the amount the program cannot exceed <u>from</u> \$10,500,000 to \$40,000,000 and further provides that proprietary schools must be allocated no more than 25% of the amount each year for students enrolled in such schools.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
