1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1518(A)(2), 1518.1(A)(2) and 1519.1(12), relative to the
3	definition of "medically indigent" in the context of the provision of health care
4	services; to provide for a definition; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:1518(A)(2), 1518.1(A)(2) and 1519.1(12) are hereby amended and
7	reenacted to read as follows:
8	§1518. E. A. Conway Medical Center; merger with Louisiana State University
9	Health Sciences Center at Shreveport
10	A. * * *
11	(2) The medical center shall be operated primarily for the medical care of the
12	uninsured and medically indigent, as defined in R.S. 17:1519.1(12), residents of the
13	state and others in need of medical care and as a teaching institution. "Medically
14	indigent" means any person below two hundred percent of the Federal Poverty Level
15	and uninsured.
