<u>Present law</u> provides that the total amount of combined contributions for both the primary and general elections that may be accepted by a candidate and his principal and subsidiary campaign committees from political committees will not exceed \$80,000 for major office candidates, \$60,000 for district office candidates, and \$20,000 for other office candidates in aggregate.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the limitation on combined contributions for both the primary and general elections that may be accepted by any candidate and his principal and subsidiary campaign committees from a political committee.

Effective August 1, 2020.

(Repeals R.S. 18:1505.2(H)(7)(a))
