To enact R.S. 32:388.2, relative to traffic regulation and penalties; to provide for maximum penalty imposed on certain drivers per traffic stop; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 32:388.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows: §388.2. Penalties; maximum Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the total amount of penalties issued pursuant to this Subpart to an owner or driver of any vehicle or combination of vehicles transporting farm and forest products in their natural state, transporting seed cotton modules, transporting cotton seed from the gin to the mill, transporting raw sugar from the mill to the refinery, or transporting brewer's grain shall be limited and shall not exceed one thousand dollars during any one traffic stop.

## DIGEST

Proposed law provides that notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the total amount of penalties issued pursuant to certain provisions of law to an owner or driver of any vehicle or combination of vehicles transporting farm and forest products in their natural state, transporting seed cotton modules, transporting cotton seed from the gin to the mill, transporting raw sugar from the mill to the refinery, or transporting brewer's grain shall be limited and shall not exceed $\$ 1,000$ during any one traffic stop.
