| 13 | H. The Department of Wildlife and Fisheries and the Louisiana Wildlife |
| 14 | and Fisheries Commission may employ the timetables and provisions of R.S. |
| 15 | 49:953(B) in promulgating rules and regulations relative to hunting seasons, |
| 16 | trapping seasons, alligator seasons, shrimp seasons, oysters seasons, and finfish |
| 17 | seasons and size limits, and all rules and regulations pursuant thereto. Rules |
| 18 | adopted annually pursuant to this Subsection which open and close the offshore |
| 19 | and fall shrimp seasons, the oyster seasons, the marine finfish seasons, the |
| 20 | webless migratory game bird hunting season, and the trapping season shall be |
| 21 | effective for the duration of the respective season. Notwithstanding the |
| 22 | provisions of R.S. 49:953(B)(4), any legislative oversight hearing held on a rule |

| 22 | (28) May in accordance with law impose, by rule promulgated in |
| 23 | accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, a fee for nonresident |
| 24 | recreational hunting licenses and nonresident recreational fishing licenses. The fee |

| 26 | R.S. 49:967(D) shall not apply to the adoption of the fees authorized by this |
