2	To amend and reenact R.S. 13:5107(A), relative to service of citation and process; to
3	provide relative to service of citation and process upon the state and state agencies;
4	to provide certain procedures, terms, conditions, and effects; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 13:5107(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§5107. Service of citation and process
9	A. (1) In all suits filed against the state of Louisiana or a state agency,
10	citation and service may be obtained by citation and service on the attorney general
11	of Louisiana, or on any employee in his office above the age of sixteen years, or any
12	other proper officer or person, depending upon the identity of the named defendant
13	and in accordance with the laws of this state, and on the department, board,
14	commission, or agency head or person, depending upon the identity of the named
15	defendant and in accordance with the laws of this state, and on the department,
16	board, commission, or agency head or person, depending upon the identity of the
17	named defendant and the identity of the named board, commission, department,
18	agency, or officer through which or through whom suit is to be filed against.
19	(2) Service shall be requested upon the attorney general within ninety
20	days of filing suit. This shall be sufficient to comply with the requirements of
21	Subsection D of this Section and also Code of Civil Procedure Article 1201(C).
22	However, the duty of the defendant served through the attorney general to
23	answer the suit or file other responsive pleadings does not commence to run
24	until the additional service required upon the department, board, commission,
25	or agency head has been made.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
