AN ACT

To enact R.S. 37:693(B)(5), relative to the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board; to provide powers, duties, and jurisdiction of the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board; to provide relative to the licensure of naval architects and marine engineers; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 37:693(B)(5) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§693. Requirements for licensure as a professional engineer or professional land surveyor, and certification as an engineer intern or land surveyor intern

* * *

B. The minimum requirements for licensure or certification by the board shall be as follows:

* * *

(5) A professional naval architect or marine engineer shall be either:
(a) An individual who holds a bachelor of science degree in naval architecture and marine engineering, or an equivalent board approved curriculum, from an accredited engineering curriculum of four years or more approved by the board as being of satisfactory standing, who is of good character and reputation, who has twenty or more years of progressive
