## AN ACT To amend and reenact R.S. 23:665(B) and 667(B), and R.S. 51:2231(C), 2232(12), and 2235(9), relative to the Equal Pay for Women Act; to provide for prohibited discrimination in employment; to provide for jurisdiction; to provide for prescription; to provide for suspension of prescription; to provide for agencies; and to provide for related matters. Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

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B. If an employer fails to resolve the dispute to the satisfaction of such employee within the time provided herein, the employee may file a complaint with the commission requesting an investigation of the complaint pursuant to R.S. 23:301 51:2257.

16\* \*17§667. Limitation of actions

19B. This one-year prescriptive period shall be suspended during the sixty-day20period allowed the employer by this Chapter to respond to the employee's written21notice, during the pendency of any administrative review or investigation of the22employee's claim by the commission Louisiana Commission on Human Rights or23the United States Department of Labor Equal Employment Opportunity24Commission, or both.

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25 Section 2. R.S. 51:2231(C), 2232(12), and 2235(9) are hereby amended and 26 reenacted to read as follows:

27 §2231. Statement of purpose; limitation on prohibitions against discrimination
