SENATE BILL NO. 324

CRIME/PUNISHMENT. Provides relative to obstruction of a highway of commerce.
(8/15/10)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 14:96 and 14:97, relative to obstructing highways of commerce;
3 to provide for elements of the crime; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 14:96 and 14:97 are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
6 follows:

7 §96. Aggravated obstruction of a highway of commerce

8 Aggravated obstruction of a highway of commerce is the intentional or
9 criminally negligent placing of anything, ~~or performance of any act~~, on any railway,
10 railroad, navigable waterway, road, highway, thoroughfare, or runway of an airport,
11 wherein it is foreseeable that human life might be endangered.

12 Whoever commits the crime of aggravated obstruction of a highway of
13 commerce shall be imprisoned, with or without hard labor, for not more than fifteen
14 years.

15 §97. Simple obstruction of a highway of commerce

16 Simple obstruction of a highway of commerce is the intentional or criminally
17 negligent placing of anything ~~or performance of any act~~ on any railway, railroad,

1 navigable waterway, road, highway, thoroughfare, or runway of an airport, which
2 will render movement thereon more difficult.

3 Whoever commits the crime of simple obstruction of a highway of commerce
4 shall be fined not more than two hundred dollars, or imprisoned for not more than
5 six months, or both.

DIGEST

Proposed law provides for an element of the crime of obstruction of a highway of commerce which includes "the performance of any act."

Proposed law changes the element of the crime of obstruction of a highway of commerce by deleting "performance of any act."

Effective August 15, 2010.
