12	C. If the contractor has provided all necessary documents to the public
13	entity within ten days of the opening of bids and no bid challenge has been
14	submitted to the public entity, the contractor and public entity shall execute the
15	contract not later than forty-five days from the public entity's acceptance of the
16	lowest responsible bid.
17	$\underline{\mathbf{D}}$. Upon the execution of the contract, the public entity, within thirty days
18	thereafter, shall issue to the contractor a notice to proceed with the project.
19	However, upon mutual consent by both parties, the notice to proceed may be
20	extended.
21	$\overline{\mathbf{D}}$. $\underline{\mathbf{E}}$. These provisions shall not be subject to waiver.
22	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012; if vetoed by the governor
