<u>Present law</u> provides for the preparation of the executive budget by the governor and its submission to the legislature.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further requires that the governor and commissioner of administration consult with the members of the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance during the development of the executive budget and take into consideration any suggestions made by the members relative to the budget proposal.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
