12	(G)(1) Each city, parish, and other local public school systems shall
13	administer mental health evaluations to high school student athletes who are

2	A.(1) Each postsecondary education institution shall administer mental
3	health evaluations to all athletes enrolled at its institution who are injured while
4	participating in an intercollegiate athletic event.
5	(2) Each institution shall provide mental health resources to assist
6	student athletes in recovering after being injured if necessary or appropriate.
7	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall be implemented by each high school and
8	the Board of Regents beginning with the 2025-2026 school year.
9	Section 3. The provisions of this Act shall be known and cited as the "You Are More
0	Than Your Sport Act".
1	Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
12	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
3	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
4	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
15	effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that all city, parish, and other local public school systems and each postsecondary education institution must administer mental health evaluations on high school and college student athletes who have been injured while participating in interscholastic and intercollegiate athletic events.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the school system and each postsecondary institution must provide mental health resources to the injured student athlete if necessary or appropriate.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
