2	To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1995, relative to departmental complaint directives; to
3	provide with respect to the levying of fines for the failure to comply with certain
4	directives; to provide for the discretion of the commissioner of insurance regarding
5	the levying of fines for the failure to comply with a directive issued by the
6	commissioner in response to a complaint; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 22:1995 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§1995. Departmental complaint directives; failure to comply; fines; hearing
10	A. Any person subject to the regulatory authority of this department the
11	<b>commissioner</b> who fails to comply with any directive issued by the commissioner
12	in connection with a consumer complaint shall may be fined an amount not to
13	exceed two hundred fifty dollars for each occurrence.
14	B. Any person against whom a fine has been levied shall be given ten days'
15	notice of such the action. Upon receipt of this notice, the person aggrieved may
16	apply for and shall be entitled to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 12 of this Title, R.S.
